And this is only one of Dee's recent awards; in March, the noted tap dancer was honored by Oklahoma City University with the 2011 Living Treasure in American Dance Award.

Past recipients of this presti-

gious award include Gus Giordano, Buster Brown, Jimmy Slyde, Dianne Walker, Arthur Duncan and Dee's mentor, Henry LeTang.

"When I found out I had won, it took me a few days to become verbal again," Dee says. "I was quite speechless." To receive the honor, she spent a weekend at the university, attending the school's spring performances and giving master classes for OCU's American Spirit Dance Company. "College students are like vacuum cleaners," she says. "They absorb as much information as they can, and they just love being there, so, in some ways, they make my job pretty easy."

About 140 dancers were present for her class, but that didn't faze Dee, who's used to large, packed convention centers. Going

into her 44th year of teaching, she is on faculty at Dance Olympus, Dance Masters of America, Dance Educators of America, Dance Makers and the *Dance Teacher* Summit. She also hosts the annual Debbi Dee Tap Intensive, this year October 22–23, in Boca Raton, FL.

Dee's favorite classes are those in which she teaches other teachers, and she stresses the importance of continuing to take class no matter what stage of your career you are in. "I've always said, 'The day that I stop learning is the day that I hang up my tap shoes,'" she says. "I learn something every single day whether I am in class teaching or taking." —Rachel Zar
